Description

Amongst the many items in Essential Baggage there is a good small sized Imperial Dining Table that was likely to have come from Thomas Butler's workshop, an interesting Ebonized Bookcase with lion mask handles and removable legs, a rare campaign Sofa Table, an early Campaign Chest with a jack in the box to the back, a South Africa Chair taken by John Disney of the Essex Regiment, 2 Whale Bone Swords, an exceptional Secretaire Cabinet Box and a pair of watercolours showing the interior of a ships' cabin furnished with campaign equipment.

This catalogue has a guest article on Brighton Bun Candlesticks by Nicholas Brawer.
